**ORDER APPROVING DISTRIBUTION OF NET SETTLEMENT FUND**

Whereas, this Court approved the terms of the Stipulation of Settlement dated August 31, 2021 and approved the Plan of Allocation by order dated January 26, 2022;

Whereas, this Court retained jurisdiction of this Action for the purpose of supervising the implementation of the Stipulation and distribution of the Net Settlement Fund;

Whereas, this Court has reviewed the Motion for Order of Distribution, the Declaration Of Jordan Broker In Support Of Lead Plaintiff’s Motion For An Order Authorizing Distribution Of Class Action Settlement Proceeds (“Broker Decl.”), related documents, and good cause showing,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:


1. That Class Plaintiff’s motion is GRANTED;
2. The administrative determinations of the Claims Administrator to accept the claims listed in Exhibits B-1 and B-2 to the Broker Declaration and described in ¶34 of the Broker

Declaration, including claims submitted after the filing deadline, are approved and those claims are accepted;

3. The administrative determinations of the Claims Administrator to reject the claims listed in Exhibit B-3 to the Broker Declaration and described in ¶34 of the Broker Declaration are approved and those claims are rejected;
4. The Claims Administrator is authorized to make the distributions described in Class Plaintiff's motion and the Broker Declaration;
5. The payments to be distributed to Authorized Claimants shall bear the notation "DEPOSIT PROMPTLY, VOID AND SUBJECT TO RE-DISTRIBUTION IF NOT NEGOTIATED WITHIN 90 DAYS OF DISTRIBUTION."
6. The Claims Administrator shall continue to receive, review and process any correspondence or information submitted by claimants with respect to already-filed Proofs of Claim. Should there be any adjustments to any Proofs of Claim prior to distribution of the Net Settlement Fund, the Claims Administrator shall update its claims database with the new information and report the updated total to Class Counsel prior to distribution;
7. All persons who were involved in the review, verification, calculation, tabulation, or any other aspect of the administration of claims filed in this Action, and all persons who were involved in the administration or taxation of the Net Settlement Fund, are released from liability for any and all claims arising out of such activities; and
8. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over any further application or matter which may arise in connection with this Action.
